Thus, the month of September saw new collaborations and the strengthening of existing partnerships.



Since September 8, 2020, the EMP-ABB has the great privilege of having Commander Abel Poudiougou as one of its Permanent Instructors among its military component.

Commander Poudiougou is an officer of the 29th promotion of the EMIA (2004-2007), having served as Section Chief at the 812th CIM; Deputy Director of Classical Training CAT1; Instructor at the CIA; Intelligence Officer at Ménaka; Intelligence Officer 7th Military Region/Kidal; Commander 721st CCAS/Kidal; Acting Director of Studies and Instructor-Director of Training at EMIA/Koulikoro; Commander Sub-Sector Diabaly and cumulatively Commander 222nd CIM/DIABALY; Professor at the National Staff School in Koulikoro and co-author of the Malian manual on the law of armed conflict.

Arrival: Lieutenant Amadou Touré Permanent Instructor at EMP-ABB



In September 2020, **Gendarmerie Lieutenant Amadou Touré**, training gendarme and brigade commander, former UNPOL, specialized in judicial procedures and security interventions (shooting and intervention techniques instructor, professional intervention instructor) **joined the team of trainers of the police component at the EMP-ABB as a permanent instructor.**

Successively Commander of the Territorial Brigade of Gendarmerie of Kangaba (Koulikoro); Deputy Commander of Squadron 5/7 of Koro (Mopti); Support/Logistics Officer (Les Cayes, Haiti); Police Instructor, Technical Advisor MINUSTAH (Les Cayes, Haiti); Associate Expert to the Head of the SDPJ at the MINUJUSTH police station (Les Cayes, Haiti); Commander of the Gendarmerie Fluvial Brigade in Mopti; Acting Deputy Commander of the Fluvial Brigade in Bamako; Investigator at the Judicial Investigation Service (SIJ) of the gendarmerie of Camp I in Bamako; Monitor at the National Training Center for Security Forces (CNEFS); Group leader of the Intervention Squad of the National Gendarmerie (PIGN) in Bamako; Gendarmerie Lieutenant Amadou Touré decided to share his expertise and experience with the EMP-ABB trainees, in order to enrich their knowledge and contribute to the expansion of the culture of peace.

Departure: Guylaine Roy Permanent Instructor at EMP-ABB



Police Sergeant Guylaine Roy, a member of the Sûreté du Québec's provincial police organization since April 1997 and assigned to the patrol as Supervisory Sergeant in 2008, was chosen in June 2019 by the RCMP (Royal Canadian Mounted Police) to participate in a peace mission in Mali. Thus, Sergeant Guylaine Roy joined the EMP-ABB in Bamako as an advisor within the Police Component, more specifically for the training component in community policing.

In March 2020, her early return to Canada due to COVID-19, allowed her to seize a professional opportunity. Sergeant Guylaine Roy was appointed Alternate Chief of Station at the Estrie highway police station in Quebec, where she is now in charge of managing police and civilian human resources.

"Working at the EMP-ABB has made me realize that I am committed to harmonious working relationships and I want to ensure that my presence in this new position in the Eastern Townships is marked by mutual assistance and respect, just as my Malian colleagues have shown me so well during my time with them.
