24th Regular Session of the EMP-ABB's Board of Directors

On Thursday, December the 3rd, 2020, was held the 24th ordinary session of the Board of Directors of the Peacekeeping School Alioune Blondin Beye de Bamako, chaired by the Minister of Defense and Veterans Affairs, Colonel Sadio Camara.

After the introductory speech by the Chairman of the Board of Directors, the verification of the mandates and the validation of the minutes of the 23rd session, as well as the proposed agenda for this 24th session, the countries and organizations, members of the EMP-ABB Board of Directors, namely Mali, ECOWAS, Germany, Japan, France, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, Switzerland, the Kingdom of Denmark, Canada, the United Kingdom, and the Kingdom of Morocco as observer, discussed about 2020's financial situation and prospects for 2021.

This session was an opportunity for the **Director General of the Peacekeeping School Alioune Blondin Beye de Bamako, General Mody Béréthé and his staff**, to present the results obtained and the budget management of the past year, as well as the projections for the coming year.

The Minister of Defense and Veterans Affairs, Chairman of the Board of Directors, praised the work of the EMP-ABB, the leadership of its management, its transparent and efficient management of financial and human resources, the raising of the level of security and defense and the acquisition of new human resources necessary to strengthen the quality of services, and encouraged the institution to maintain its high standards before renewing the commitment of his department to mobilize all possible means to support this process.

The Chairman of the Board of Directors concluded his speech by thanking the partners who have supported Mali through their commitment to the Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin Beye de Bamako.





The Board took note of Algeria's wish to become a member of the Board of Directors of the Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin Beye. He also welcomed the interest of the Kingdom of Spain and that of Norway in the School which, like all major international institutions involved in peace support operations, is open to all nations and organizations wishing to contribute to the promotion of the culture of peace.

During the month of December 2020, the EMP-ABB had the privilege to contribute to the exchanges between the main actors in charge of issues related to the strengthening of peace and stability, through workshops, seminars, colloquiums and symposiums.

On Tuesday, December 8, 2020, the EMP-ABB hosted and co-organized with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI), as well as its Center for Strategic Studies (CES), and the Konrad Adenauer Stiftung Foundation (KAS), a workshop on the political transition in Mali on the theme "Reforms of the electoral system and timeline for the electoral process.
