

On Friday, January 29, 2021, **Dr. Lt-Col Abdoulaye Maïga, Minister of Territorial Administration and Decentralization** participated as thesis supervisor in the defense of Mr. Khalil Sidy Touré on the theme of "**The Role of Civil Society in the Reform of the Security Sector**".

As a reminder, the Minister of Territorial Administration and Decentralization holds a doctorate in International Security and defense from the University Jean Moulin Lyon 3 of the Doctoral School of Law "ED 492".

The jury was composed of Dr. Coulibaly Abdrahamane, Acting Director of CARESS and President of the jury; Colonel Aliou Bagayoko, Director of Instruction at EMP-ABB, and Dr. Monzon Traoré, from the Institut d'Études Politiques de Grenoble (IEP), better known as Sciences Po Grenoble.

This presentation is part of the first cohort of auditors for the **double master's degree in** "Peacekeeping" and "Post-Conflict State Reconstruction" at the EMP-ABB's Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahel-Saharan Region (CARESS), in collaboration with the Institut d'Études Politiques de Grenoble (IEP).







In January 20201, the EMP-ABB was honored by the promotion to the rank of **Divisional Commissioner** of Baba Mariko, Head of its Police Component and permanent instructor, and Saouty Fofana, the Director of Courses.

On the distinction aspect, Commander Abel Poudiougou, permanent instructor at the EMP-ABB, received the "Certificat de Satisfecit" issued by the National Staff School of Koulikoro (EEMNK), for the training of three (03) promotions of staff officers representing a total of nine (09) African countries.
