# The International Seminar of EMP-ABB's Alumni

On **November 10, 11 and 12, 2021**, the Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin Beye de Bamako (**EMP-ABB**), organized the **first edition of the International Seminar of its Alumni**.

This activity, financed by the **Federal Republic of Germany** through its diplomatic representation in Mali, provided the opportunity to honor the human resources trained at the school.





As a reminder, the alumni of the EMP-ABB are former trainees of the school as well as students of its Master in Peacekeeping and its Executive Master in Post-Conflict State Reconstruction. These two masters are delivered by EMP-ABB's Center for Analysis and Research on the Sahel-Saharan Space (CARESS), in partnership with the Institute of Political Studies (IEP), Sciences Po Grenoble and the University of Legal and Political Sciences (USJP) of Bamako.



Placed under the theme of "The Impact of EMP-ABB's Trainings on the Socio-Professional Careers of its Alumni: Challenges and Perspectives", this first edition recorded, among others, the participation of his Excellency Dr. Dietrich Fritz Reinhold Pohl, Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany in Mali, the Alumni Coordinator, Mr. Mohamed Ahmad El Ansar, the Director General of the Ecole Maintien Paix Alioune Blondin Beye de Bamako, Colonel Souleymane Sangaré, numerous guests from diplomatic representations accredited to Mali, governmental and non-governmental organizations; as well as 14 alumni from Mali, Côte d'Ivoire, Niger, Cameroon, Mauritania, Senegal, Burundi, Guinea, Burkina Faso, Togo, Benin, Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), Chad and Gabon.









Thus, the general objective of the international seminar was to create a space for sustainable training-employment dialogue between the Alumini of the EMP-ABB and potential employers, with a view to continuing the collection of data relating to the evaluation of the impact of the trainings received.

The three (03) days of the activity were punctuated by a workshop on the production of a career follow-up plan for alumni and five (05) panels addressing the following themes:

- 1- Testimonies and exchanges on the impact of the EMP-ABB's trainings on professional careers;
- 2- Optimization of the quality of EMP-ABB's trainings in the face of the new challenges of peace building in Africa;















- 3- Accompaniment towards employment: Presentation of EMP-ABB's alumni to potential employers;
- 4- What strategies should be developed to continue to stimulate the participation rate of women in EMP-ABB's trainings?
- 5- Roles and commitments of alumni in the realization of EMP-ABB's objectives.

The Director General of EMP-ABB, Colonel Souleymane Sangaré, has expressed the wish to hold an **annual international seminar dedicated to the alumni of his institution**.

## Anti-COVID19 vaccination campaign at EMP-ABB

On Tuesday, November 30, 2021, EMP-ABB launched its anti-COVID19 vaccination campaign.

Under the coordination and supervision of **Dr. Birama Apho Ly**, the new director of the Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahel-Saharan Space (**CARESS**), a team of professionals from the **Reference Health Center** (**CSREF**) of **Commune IV** was able to vaccinate all the volunteers of EMP-ABB staff, support staff and trainees present during the campaign; a total of **69 people in addition to those already vaccinated**.

The EMP-ABB anti-COVID19 (DAC2020) system identified two (02) positive cases on Friday, November 26, out of a total of **72 PCR tests**; one international trainee and one EMP-ABB staff member. All evidence led to the conclusion that the infections occurred outside the school premises. As a result, access to EMP-ABB was restricted for 24 hours, while disinfection measures were carried out as planned in this type of scenario.

Please continue to observe the barrier measures and respect the anti-COVID19 apparatus (DAC2020) of the EMP-ABB.
