As a reminder, the training in Gender Responsive Planning and Budgeting (**GRPB**) is part of the continued implementation of the Capacity Building for Women Vectors of Change for Peace and Sustainable Development (**RECAFEVEC**) project, funded by the Embassy of the Kingdom of Norway in Mali. The Bamako session took place from **July 4 to 8, 2022** at the Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (**EMP-ABB**) de Bamako.

The objective of this training is to strengthen the capacities of local actors and partners involved in the planning and execution process of local government budgets and decentralized state services to better take into account the gender aspect.

Development of a new course at EMP-ABB: SSR Level 2





From Monday, June 27 to Friday, July 1, 2022, the Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (EMP-ABB) de Bamako, proceeded with the development of the level 2 of the Security Sector Reform (SSR 2) course.

Funded by the **Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Mali**, a partner country and member of the EMP-ABB Board of Directors, this development of the SSR Level 2 course aims to continue building the capacities of actors involved in the design and implementation of security sector reform programs. This new course is intended for national and international trainees who have already successfully completed the SSR Level 1 course.

The objective of the course is to deepen the concept of SSR; to undertake sectoral reforms within the framework of SSR; and to explain the synergy between SSR and other cross-cutting issues.


The Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (**EMP-ABB**) de Bamako, through its Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahel-Saharan Space (CARESS), proceeded on **Tuesday, July 12, 2022**, to the signature of a partnership agreement with the **CEVRO Institute**.

The CEVRO Institute is a private university in **Prague, Czech Republic**, created in 2005 by the **CEVRO Group**. The objective of this partnership is to establish a non-exclusive cooperation framework of facilitation and mutual support between the two (02) structures, essentially based on research and analysis in the field of peace, security and development.

Thus, the implementation of the terms of the agreement will enable the two centers to **benefit** from complementary exchanges of expertise in the field of research and analysis, including the gender perspective, at the sub-regional level.

In addition to the signing of the partnership agreement with the CEVRO Institute, we can mention the following activities:

The Ecole de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (**EMP-ABB**) of Bamako, through its Centre d'Analyse et de Recherche de l'Espace Sahélo-Saharien (**CARESS**), held on Thursday, **July 14, 2022**, the 9th edition of its reading club.

The activity was attended by the Ambassador of the Czech Republic, **His Excellency Mr. Robert Kopecký**, accompanied by the Director General of EMP-ABB, **Colonel Souleymane SANGARE.**

During this 9th edition, two (02) books and their authors were honored. **Mr. Vojteh BILY** who is a researcher at the CEVRO Institute in Prague presented a work entitled "**Quand les mangues tombent**" (*When the mangoes fall*). It describes the horrors of the civil war, its consequences, as well as the process of talks of the Central African crisis having started in 2013. The second author, **Mr. Issiaka SIDIBE** with its "**Championnat de tricherie suivi d'un poste braisé**" (*Championship of cheating followed by a braised position*) proposes a play articulated around three acts and six scenes that invite us into the meanders of the intrigues of the Malian school world in search of reference points.







The monthly sessions of the CARESS book club bring together authors, journalists, researchers, students and book lovers on the themes of peace, security and development. They aim to promote the culture of peace and to exchange ideas and books on the subject.
