


Team building: EMP-ABB's **Annual Cohesion Strengthening Day**

01/12/2022 – Participation of the Director General of EMP-ABB in the restitution and planning workshop following the regional conference on resource management in the defense and security sector of Mali, Burkina Faso, Niger, Mauritania and Chad;

02/02/2022 – Inauguration and official handing over of hydrological, solar and computer equipment by Japan, through His Excellency Mr. Daisuke KUROKI, Ambassador of Japan to Mali in the presence of Mr. Jo SCHEUER, UNDP Resident Representative in Mali; Colonel Souleymane SANGARE, Director General of EMP-ABB; EMP-ABB executives; as well as many trainees;

From 03/23 to 25/2022 - Working visit of a delegation from EMP-ABB, composed of the Director General of EMP-ABB, Colonel Souleymane SANGARE and his delegation consisting of the Director of the Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahel-Saharan Space (CARESS), Dr. Birama Apho Ly; the Director of Training (DI), Colonel Aliou Bagayoko and the Partnership Officer of the Directorate of Communication and Institutional Development (DCDI), Mrs. Madina Badian KOUYATE in the Kingdom of Morocco, member of the Board of Directors of the school, within the framework of the reinforcement of the partnership links;

04/19/2022 – Hosting of a meeting between the Parliamentary Secretary of State of the German Ministry of Development Cooperation, Dr. Bärbel Kofler; representatives of the Sahel Alliance in Mali and those of the World Bank, to exchange on the challenges related to the various development cooperation programs;

From 05/19 to 20/2022 - Participation of the EMP-ABB Director General in the International High Level Seminar and Reflection Workshop for Francophone Peacekeeping Training Actors in Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC);

From 06/11 to 17/2022 - Working visit of the Director General of EMP-ABB, Colonel Souleymane SANGARE and his Chief of the Police Component, Divisional Commissioner Baba MARIKO to Berlin, for a tripartite meeting between EMP-ABB, the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) and the Federal Republic of Germany;

07/12/2022 - Signing of a partnership agreement between the École de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (EMP-ABB) de Bamako, through its Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahel-Saharan Space (CARESS) and the CEVRO Institute, a private university of Prague, in the Czech Republic.
