

Enhancement of Cooperation: Visit of an Algerian Delegation to EMP-ABB

EMP-ABB NEWS N°0523 www.empbamako.org As part of the implementation of the military cooperation program between the **People's Democratic Republic of Algeria** and the **Republic of Mali** for the year 2023, an Algerian delegation paid a visit to the Alioune Blondin BEYE Peacekeeping Training School (**EMP-ABB**) in Bamako on **Monday, May 15th**.

As a reminder, the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria is a member of the Board of Directors (CA) of EMP-ABB. This visit demonstrates the commitment of both countries to **strengthen their partnership in the field of training**.

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The Algerian delegation, led by Major General Ahmed SAYEH MOHAMED, also included Colonel Nemr AZOUZ, Colonel Ben Djamaa ZOUBIR, and Lieutenant Colonel Marzoug **BELKACEM**. They were welcomed by **Colonel** Souleymane SANGARE, the Director-General of EMP-ABB, as well as the school's directors, the Chief of Staff, and the Partnership Officer.

The visit program consisted of various activities. Firstly, a welcome session and speeches took place in the school's conference Colonel Souleymane SANGARE room. expressed his satisfaction with the visit of the Algerian delegation and emphasized the importance of strengthening cooperation between the, an international training center in themember country of the Board of and his school field Directors peacekeeping. Major General Ahmed SAYEH MOHAMED also delivered а speech. highlighting Algeria's commitment to promoting a culture of peace in Mali and the rest of Africa.

Subsequently, a general presentation of EMP-ABB was given, with particular emphasis on the partnership between the school and Algeria. The delegation members had the opportunity to ask questions and engage in discussions with EMP-ABB officials.















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After a coffee break to allow for informal exchanges, the delegation visited the facilities of EMP-ABB, where training sessions were underway. This visit provided the delegation members with an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the school's activities and infrastructure.

The visit concluded with the signing of the guestbook and the exchange of symbolic gifts in the VIP room of the school. This step served to further strengthen friendship and cooperation.

Finally, the Algerian delegation continued their visit by proceeding to the **Ministry of Defense and Veterans Affairs of Mali (MDAC)**, where additional discussions on military cooperation took place.

This visit by the Algerian delegation to EMP-ABB marks an important milestone in the strengthening of cooperation between EMP-ABB and the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria, a member of its Board of Directors. It demonstrates the willingness of both countries to work together to promote peace, security, and development in the region.


















The École de Maintien de la Paix Alioune Blondin BEYE (EMP-ABB), in partnership with the West Africa Catholic University - Bamako University Unit (UCAO-UUBa), hosted the 2nd edition of the International Symposium on "Contribution of Science to Integration Efforts for Peace and Development in the Sahel." The event took place from May 25th to 27th, 2023, at the EMP-ABB premises in Bamako.





This renowned symposium brought together a panel of multidisciplinary experts, including philosophers, historians, sociologists, anthropologists, geographers, jurists, economists, political scientists, and representatives from national, regional, and sub-regional institutions. The main objective of this three-day gathering was to examine the role of science in regional integration processes and to promote peace and sustainable development in the Sahel.



Several high-level personalities participated in the event, including Mr. Yacouba KEBE, Chief of Staff to the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, who presided over the opening and closing ceremonies. Also in attendance were Mr. Moussa GUINDO, Technical Advisor to the Minister of Malians Abroad and African Integration, as well as the High Representative and Head of the African Union Mission for Mali and the Sahel (MISAHEL), His Excellency Mahamane Sambo SIDIKU. The symposium was also honored by the presence of Dr. Clément LONAH, President of UCAO-Unité Universitaire de Bamako, Dr. Benjamin AKOTIA, Assessor of UCAO, and Colonel Souleymane SANGARE, Director General of EMP-ABB.

Discussions focused on a multitude of crucial topics related to African integration, peace, and development. Speakers analyzed issues of governance, democracy, security, education, culture, information and communication technologies (ICT), and borders in the Sahel context. The rich and diverse exchanges deepened the understanding of the challenges facing the region and explored opportunities for collaboration to promote integration and progress.

















The workshops and panel sessions were led by renowned experts in their respective fields. Among the topics discussed were "Cross-border cooperation as a factor for peace, stability, and development integration," "Cross-border integration of skills: a response to terrorism in Africa," "Transforming African educational systems by 2030: challenges and potentials," "ICT and integration: contributing to peace and development," and many more.

This symposium provided participants with an opportunity to update their knowledge, establish professional contacts, and exchange innovative ideas. The outcomes and recommendations formulated during this event will assist organizers and involved institutions in enhancing their online training, research, and development initiatives with the ultimate goal of promoting regional integration and fostering lasting peace in the Sahel.








16th Edition: From Donsoya to Donsology







Mr. Fodé Moussa B SIDIBE, professor at the Faculty of Letters, Languages, and Linguistics (FLSL) of the University of Letters and Human Sciences of Bamako (ULSHB), is the author of this essay dedicated to the brotherhood of hunters, Donso. Through a thorough analysis of field data, the author takes us on an initiatory journey into the mystical universe of this group that played a central role in the traditions of the Niger Basin. According to Dr. Sidibé, his book explores "the foundations of the Donso brotherhood while also questioning other complex aspects of the spirituality of ancient Mandé."
