«Demographic Dynamics, Peace, Security and Development in the Sahel»

From **October 9 to 11, 2023**, the Alioune Blondin BEYE Peacekeeping School (EMP-ABB) of Bamako hosted a high-level international seminar on the theme "Demographic Dynamics, Peace, Security and Development in the Sahel".

Funded by the Federal Republic of Germany, the seminar brought together the participation of eminent personalities and distinguished experts to analyze the impact of demographic dynamics on peace, security and development in the Sahel.

Context:

According to the UN, the total population of the six (6) Sahel states has increased fivefold in sixty years (UNDESA, 2019). Besides, the same studies show that the combined populations of the six countries in the Sahel and northern Nigeria are expected to grow from 181 million to more than 370 million by 2045.

Justification:

This strong growth requires the concerned States to build new infrastructures, increase agricultural productivity and expand the labor market not only to meet the pressing need for gainful employment among an already largely underemployed workforce, but also to maintain their collective security.



Objectives and Targets of the Seminar

This seminar aimed to deepen the reflection on the correlation between demography, peace, security, and development in the Sahel countries in order to propose possible solutions for a successful demographic transition. This event, essential in the global dialogue on peace, was intended for government institutions, academics, CSOs, NGOs, international organizations, religious leaders and traditional legitimacies.

Seminar Development: Exchange and Elaboration

Panels of experts, bringing together enlightened and innovative minds from the sector, engaged in discussions and debates to encourage inclusive sharing of knowledge, experience and, above all, solutions adapted to the realities on the ground.



Seminar Development : (suite)

The inaugural lecture by Dr Sékou Amadou TRAORE, National Director of Population, set the tone by recalling the different currents mobilized to analyze the correlations between demography and development; between demography and conflicts in the Sahel; and between demography and development.

he audience was then informed in detail about the issues at stake through the following five panels:

- Demographic pyramid, age groups and human safety;
- 2. Women, demography and human security ;
- Youth as a potential reservoir for armed and terrorist groups;
- 4. How to make a success of the demographic transition in the Sahel;
- 5. Governance and demographic challenges.

18th Edition:

Mali, the socio-political obstacles to decentralization (1991 - 2021): Panorama of an ambitious reform



On Thursday October 12, 2023,the Alioune Blondin BEYE Peackeeping School of Bamako (EMPABB) invited the general public to the 18th edition of its Book Club, orchestrated by its Center for Analysis and Research of the Sahelo-Saharan Space (CARESS). The event took place at 3pm GMT in the CARESS library, within the EMPABB Documentation Center.

The featured work during this session was "The Sahel, geopolitical epicenter: endogenous solutions to the security challenge" by Mr. Thierno Souleymane Diop Niang, a graduate in Law, International Relations and Diplomacy at the CEDS, as well as in Public Administration at Syracuse University. A State Department Fellow with the prestigious "Mandela Washington Fellowship" program, he is a program coordinator at LEGS AFRICA, a member of the international think tank "IDOVE" and is also a columnist on Senegalese national television RTS1.

After a detailed presentation of the book, time was set aside for questions and answers. This enabled Club participants to exchange views, comment and contribute to the debate. Interaction with the author offered a unique opportunity to deepen understanding of the themes raised in the book.

The Club de Lecture brought together a diverse range of audiences, from CARESS members and students from various academic institutions, to history and politics enthusiasts. The presence of loyal Club members, mainly researchers, doctoral students and auditors from the CARESS masters program at EMP-ABB, undoubtedly enriched the debates.
