The purpose of the meeting was to better prepare for the upcoming work of the BA to correct the draft revisions of the School's basic texts (Ordinance, Decree, Order) and to review the first draft of the internship schedule for the first semester of the new year.

The meeting, which has become a well-established tradition at the School, was attended by several Counsellors and Defense Attachés from the member countries of the EMP-ABB Board of Directors.

# COMMUNITY MEDIATION COURSE DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

## Context:

The development of a course on community mediation in Mali, particularly in the regions of Sikasso, Mopti, and Timbuktu, takes place within a complex and tense socio-political, security, and judicial context. These regions share vulnerabilities that make community mediation essential for social cohesion and peace.


## Justification:

In this context, the development of a course on community mediation is necessary in order to:

- Strengthen capacities of local actors involved in the prevention, management and resolution of community conflicts;
- Promote social cohesion by providing inter-community dialogue tools to prevent radicalisation and violent extremism, particularly among young people.
- Analyse possible "compromises" between traditional and modern modes of conflict management, promoting grassroots diplomacy.

## Objective:

The objective of this course is to strengthen the capacities of community actors involved in the prevention, management and resolution of community conflicts by building on the efficient mastery of local mechanisms for conflict prevention, management and resolution.

## 39<sup>th</sup> Edition

### « Challenges of educational management in Mali: problems to be addressed »



The Alioune Blondin BÈYE Peacekeeping School (EMP-ABB) in Bamako, through its Centre for Analysis and Research on the Sahel-Saharan Region (CARESS), held the 39th edition of its book club on Thursday, 20 November 2025, in the CARESS documentation room.

The book presented by **Mr Idrissa Soïba TRAORE** was "Enjeux du pilotage pédagogique au Mali, des maux à panser" (Challenges of educational management in Mali, problems to be addressed).

This book analyses educational management through classroom practices (supervision, discipline, teaching strategies, assessment) in rural primary schools and the implementation of the Competency-Based Approach (CBA) in an urban secondary school. It examines the role of the teacher, who is often overwhelmed by overcrowded classrooms, time management and student behaviour.

The book also highlights the varying degrees to which APC is adopted in secondary schools, where each teacher applies it in their own way. The aim is to move away from a DIY approach in order to improve organisation and effectiveness.

As usual, the question-and-answer session allowed participants to contribute to the discussion and gain a deeper understanding of the book.

For this edition, the Reading Club brought together CARESS members and Club members, including researchers, doctoral students and CARESS master's students, as well as Mr TRAORE's parents, friends and supporters, who enriched the discussions with their contributions.


